RECRUITMENT PROCESS

The recruitment process has several stages:

Stage 1

From 25 January 2015 onwards, you can fill in the <u>International Crew Recruitment Survey</u>. This is the first requirement of your application.

Stage 2

From mid-April 2015 onwards, you will hear from us. Only with the progress of planning we will find the need for new members. We will contact you with questions or to schedule an online interview. If we cannot offer you a task in the Crew immediately, we still might do so at a later point, when we find that your expertise is needed.

Stage 3

Crew members are expected to be available in Vienna from 30 July 2015 morning to 9 August 2015 evening. The competition takes place from 2–8 August 2015.

CONDITIONS

By submitting your application, you agree that your data is processed by Vienna EUDC 2015, DKWien and Debattierklub Wien EUDC GmbH - we will treat your data confidentially. Should you accept to become a member of the Crew in the event of such an offer, you agree that we publish your name in public media, such as our website or a participants' brochure, and that other members of the Crew are given your contact details for use before and during the tournament. There is no right to membership in the Vienna EUDC 2015 Crew.

Members of the Crew have to adhere to the Equity Policy of Vienna EUDC 2015, as decided upon by the Vienna EUDC 2015 Equity Officers. The Vienna EUDC 2015 OrgCom reserves the right to expel a certain member at any time in cases of serious misconduct, such as posing a risk to the security of the event or severely violating the Equity Code.

International Crew members will be accommodated in a hostel during the tournament, sharing rooms with other members. The hostel is paid for by Vienna EUDC 2015. Unless we can accrue more sponsorship, international Crew members will be accommodated with debaters from Vienna before and after the tournament. International Crew members can be sharing accommodation with persons of their own gender only, if they wish to.
